## Poetry Contest Guidelines

- There are two categories according to age:
  - 16-10 years and
  - 21-25 years.
- Participants may submit one poem, in English, on any subject matter.
- Maximum length of poem is 40 lines.
- Opening date for submission: Oct 28, 2014.
- Last date for submission: Nov 14, 2014.
- Entries should be sent to: [ewingengsociety@gmail.com](mailto:ewingengsociety@gmail.com) with the subject line “Celeb Lit. Week\_Poetry Entry”.
- Must contain in the body of email:
  - Your full name.
  - Your age category
  - Your institution name (if any).
  - Total number of lines.
  - Title of the Poem.
- Entry may be in Microsoft Word or PDF format but must bear your name.
- The decision of judges will be final.
- All entries must be original and unpublished.

## Short Story Contest

- There are two categories according to age:
  - 16-20 years and
  - 21-25 years.
- Participants may submit one short story, in English, on any subject matter.
- The word limit is 2000-3000 words.
- Opening date for submission: 24<sup>th</sup> October 2014
- Closing date for submission: 14<sup>th</sup> November 2014.
- Entries should be emailed to: [ewingengsociety@gmail.com](mailto:ewingengsociety@gmail.com) with the subject line:
- “Celeb Lit. Week\_Short Story Entry”
- Must contain in the body of the email:
  - Your full name
  - Your age category
  - Your institution (if any).
  - Your word count
  - The title of your story
- Entries may be in Microsoft Word or PDF format but must be titled with the author’s name.

- The decision of judges will be final.
- All entries must be original and unpublished.

## Skit Contest

- All skits must be under 10 minutes.
- One team may only perform one skit.
- The skit must be related to or inspired by a piece of literature or multiple pieces of literature.
- Participants may re-enact scenes from books.
- There may be no more than 5 actors in the skit.
- Props are allowed.
- Monologues are allowed.

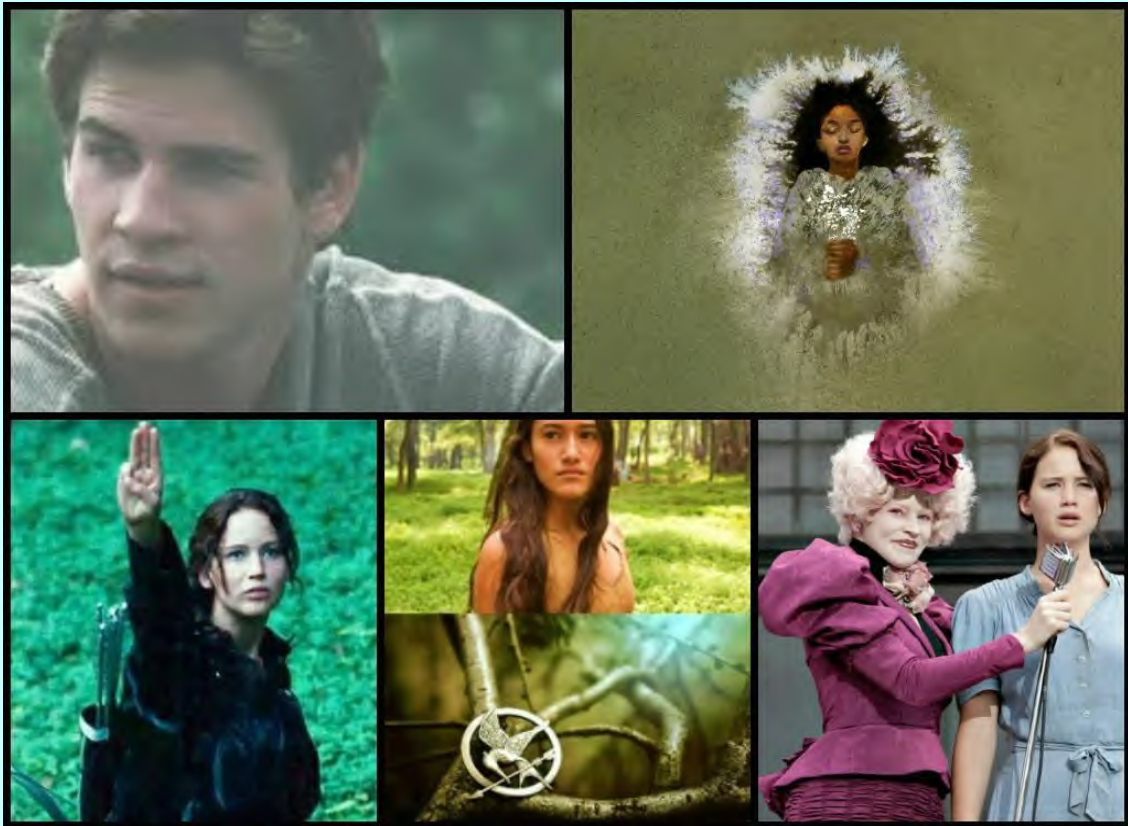
## Literary Themed Ramp Walk Contest

- Props are allowed.
- Each team can present a maximum of two people to perform in the ramp walk.
- Along with the catwalk, the models must prepare a short skit/dialogue/monologue that is related to their literary theme. This may be 2-3 minutes long e.g: For the Pride and Prejudice theme, two models can re-enact one of the dialogues between Elizabeth Bennett and Mr. Darcy.
- You can participate individually as well as a part of the team from your School/college/university.
- There is no restriction for the number of participating individuals/teams from one institution.
- The range for the team entry is 2-5 members. If your selected theme requires more participants, let us know beforehand.
- Every individual/team is allowed to use the stage for 5-8 minutes.
- Judges decision will be considered final.
